SECTION 2 — HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

SECTION 7 — HANDLING AND STORAGE

Flinn Suggested Chemical Storage Pattern: Inorganic #1. Store with metals and metal hydrides.

Handle under inert gas. Protect from moisture (P231+P232). Keep container tightly closed (P233). Store in a Flinn Chem-SafTM bag and then inside a Finn Saf-StorTM can.
